IMPORT YOUR MAILCHIMP CANVAS TO SHOWIT5

1. Login to your Showit5 account.
2. Click on your profile on the bottom lefthand corner.
3. Select "Add Design to Library".
4. Enter the following Share Key:

SHOWIT5 SHARE KEY

6q3reVXq2kDY60572

ADD CANVAS TO SITE

1. Open your primary site design.
2. On the left hand panel, select + next to “Site Canvases” to add a new site canvas.
3. Click on “Select New Site Canvas”.
4. From the tabs on the top of the pop up window, select “My Library”.
5. Choose MailChimp by Refinery Original.
6. Select the site canvas “Site Canvas Subscribe”.
7. On the bottom center of the window, you may choose to use the original design or apply your fonts and colors. Choose your preference and click “Add”.
8. You may choose to repeat this process for the trigger page or add your own trigger.

CREATE A MAILCHIMP FORM

1. Login to your MailChimp account.
2. Select “Lists” from the top menu.
3. Choose the list you want to create a subscription form for.
4. Click on “Signup Forms” on the following page.
5. Select “Embedded Forms”
6. Select the “Classic” option.
7. Deselect all fields and select the radio button “Show only required fields”.
8. Copy generated form.

ADDING IN CSS

Your form comes out of the box with basic coding. In order to give your form a branded design, we need to first add in custom code.

1. Open a text editing program (Word, Pages, TextEdit, etc.)
2. Paste your generated code onto the page.
3. Find the section beginning with `<style type="text/css">`. The closing code will be `</style>`. This is the section you'll be editing.
4. Copy and paste the following code into your mailchimp code. This code will replace the code outlined on the last page.

YOU NOW HAVE A GORGEOUSLY BRANDED FORM

The hard work is done and your code should now look like the code below (with your custom css, obviously). Here's what to do next:

1. In your Showit app, select the canvas containing your MailChimp form.
2. Select the MailChimp form.
3. On the right side panel, click on "Embed Info".
4. Paste your code into the custom code window. Your form will be generated and now gorgeously branded!

CREATE A TRIGGER

AUTOMATIC POP UP

1. Select the MailChimp canvas.
2. On the right side panel, click on animation.
3. Set the type of animation (fade, slide, etc.) and set the delay to around 5 seconds (or whatever you prefer).
4. Select the top most canvas (usually the menu) on the page that contains the pop up.
5. Select Scroll Actions on the right side menu.
6. Add an action, set it to the following:
 - Trigger: On Screen
 - Action: Show Canvas
 - Canvas: *Mailchimp Canvas*

**Helpful tip: for SEO, Google loves a user friendly website, meaning, if an automatic pop up occurs on the home page upon entering, this is viewed as not being user friendly. Automatic pop ups are beneficial on pages such as a blog or an education page. With the latest update, Google doesn't like an automatic pop up on mobile devices at all.*

ENGAGEMENT POP UP

1. Select the MailChimp canvas.
2. On the right side panel, click on animation.
3. Set the type of animation (fade, slide, etc.) and set the delay to 0.
4. Select the button or text.
5. Select Click Actions on the right side menu.
6. Add an action, set it to the following:
 - Type: Show Canvas
 - Canvas: *Mailchimp Canvas*

NO POP UP/ALWAYS VISIBLE

The canvas is set to be hidden from the start. If you want the canvas to always be visible, you will have to change this option.

1. Select the MailChimp canvas.
2. Under the Canvas section on the right hand panel, deselect "Hidden to start".
3. In the same section, change the Sticky setting to None.
